The purpose of this filing is to revise the Utah Demand-Side Management Annual Report for 2010 for full compliance with the Commission's Order in this Docket dated July 14, 2011.

Dear Mr. Lively:

The Utah Division of Public Utilities ("Division") reviewed the Company's addendum filing to the 2010 Utah Demand-Side Management Annual Report ("Report") for 2010 submitted on September 12, 2011 and determined this submission is not in full compliance with the Commission's July 14, 2011, Order in this Docket.

In this Order, the Commission directed the Company to clarify explicitly and clearly whether the reported megawatt savings from energy efficiency programs, as summarized in Report Tables 1 and 2 on pages 5 and 6, occurs at the time of system peak or to otherwise explain how the megawatt savings values are determined. The Division concludes the additional language added in the Company's addendum filing does not adequately clarify the valuation of megawatt savings referenced in these tables and therefore does not fully address the Commission's directive on this issue.

The Division recommends the Commission not acknowledge the Company's addendum filing until the Company submits the explanations to Tables 1 and 2 in the Report, as directed by the Commission. The Commission concurs with the Division's recommendation and directs the Company to more fully clarify the determination of reported megawatt savings in compliance with the Commission's July 14, 2011, Order.
