RE: Docket No. 11-035-74    The purpose of this filing is to revise the Utah Demand-Side Management Annual Report for 2010 for full compliance with the Commission's Order in this Docket dated July 14, 2011.

Dear Mr. Lively:

On October 19, 2011, the Commission directed the Company to clarify whether the reported megawatt savings from energy efficiency programs, as summarized in the 2010 Utah Demand-Side Management Annual Report ("Report") occur at the time of system peak or to otherwise explain how the megawatt savings values are determined. On December 15, 2011, the Company filed a revised addendum explaining how the megawatt savings are quantified.

The Utah Division of Public Utilities ("Division") and the Office of Consumer Services ("Office") reviewed the revised addendum and recommend the Commission acknowledge the revised addendum as providing the necessary explanations. The Office also recommends the Commission direct the Company to provide DSM capacity benefits in terms of system coincident peak and for each individual program in future DSM annual reports.

Based on the recommendations of the Division and Office, the Commission hereby accepts the Company's revised addendum as responsive to the October 19, 2011, direction for clarification. The Commission also finds the Office's additional recommendations to be reasonable and directs the Company to incorporate these recommendations in future DSM annual reports.
