First Revision of Sheet No. 107.2 Schedule 107 Solar Incentive Program

First Revision of Sheet No. 107.3 Schedule 107 Solar Incentive Program

The purpose of this filing is to make revisions to Schedule 107, Solar Incentive Program, in compliance with the Commission's order in Docket No. 07-035-T14 dated February 10, 2011. In that order, the Commission approved a reduction in the Solar Incentive Program from \$2.00 per watt to \$1.55 per watt to reflect reduced costs of solar photovoltaic system installations. The attached tariff sheets reflect the revised incentive level.

In addition, the Company proposes to move the program's last annual deadline from December 31, 2011 as reflected in Tariff Sheet No. 107.3 to June 30, 2012 to allow sufficient time for projects awarded funding in 2011 to be completed by the program deadline. Also, extending the program deadline will provide additional time to the Company to meet the objective of fully subscribing the program capacity¹ over the five year pilot term.

The Company intends to begin accepting project applications on March 24, 2011 for the 2011 program year. To align the effective date of the tariff revisions with the 2011 program year

¹ The program capacity over the five year term is 535 kW (107 kW per year X 5 years).

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application date, Rocky Mountain Power respectfully requests the changes proposed herein be approved with an effective date of March 24, 2011.
