The purpose of this filing is to advance the ENERGY STAR New Homes program (Program), which is administered through Schedule 110, with new ENERGY STAR guidelines.

Dear Mr. Lively:

On November 9, 2011, the Commission received comments from the Utah Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) on the Company’s proposed modifications to the ENERGY STAR New Homes Program (“Program”) submitted on October 17, 2011. The Division recommends the Commission approve these changes with minor corrections to the tariff sheets. The Division also expresses concern the Program marginally passes the required Utility Cost Test threshold.

The Company represents in comments filed November 16, 2011, it met with the Division and the Office of Consumer Services (“Office”) on November 15, 2011, to discuss possible tariff modifications to improve estimated Program cost effectiveness. The Company further represents the Division agreed further modifications or corrections to the tariff are not necessary at this time and the Division and Company recommend the Commission approve the Program tariff sheets as originally proposed by the Company. The Company represents the Office does not object to this agreement.

Based on the Company’s representations, the Commission approves the proposed Program modifications as filed, with an effective date of November 16, 2011.
