RECOMMENDATION

The Utah Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends the Public Service Commission (Commission) acknowledge Dixie Escalante's revised tariff sheets in Docket No. 11-066-T01, making them available for public inspection.

DISCUSSION

On January 18, 2011, in accordance with §54-7-12 (7) of the Utah Code Title 54, Dixie Escalante file revised Electric Service Regulation No. 8 with the Commission to lower the fees charged from \$30.00 to \$20.00 for a customer subject to a disconnection for lack of payment if the service order has been processed and the meter technician had been dispatched at the time payment is made. The Cooperative also reduced the setup fee from \$30.00 to \$10.00 to change the name on an existing account.

Dixie Escalante added a paragraph in their Electric Service Regulation No. 10, Line Extension Policy, out lining their Street Light Installation and Maintenance policy for developers and

property owners. Also included was a revised Net Metering tariff that complies with current state laws and regulations.

These revisions and additions were approved by the Cooperative's Board of Directors on January 5, 2011.
