By The Commission:

This matter is before the Commission on the Utah Office of Consumer Service's ("Office") Motion for Protective Order – Additional Protective Measures, filed September 12, 2011. No party has filed a response to the motion, and the time for response has expired.

In its motion, the Office requests the Commission to impose additional protective measures for the "Report on Rocky Mountain Power Fuel Management and Coal Supply" ("Report") prepared at the Office's request by Energy Ventures Analysis. The Report was prepared as part of the Office's analysis of PacifiCorp's fuel management and coal supply operations, policy and procedure, and strategy. The Report is part of the Office's ongoing assessment of the impact of rate changes and resource planning on PacifiCorp's Utah residential and small commercial customers, pursuant to the Office's statutory duties. *See* Utah Code Ann. § 54-10a-301.

In its motion, the Office states PacifiCorp has imposed blanket restrictions on access to the fuel management and coal supply information PacifiCorp provided to the Office in connection with Energy Ventures Analysis' preparation of the Report. The Office acknowledges some of the information PacifiCorp provided, if disclosed to a competitor, would create a high risk of competitive disadvantage or other business injury. The Office, however, also states it

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cannot create a public version of the Report that reliably protects the confidentiality of PacifiCorp's competitive information because the Office does not know what information PacifiCorp considers highly confidential, confidential, and non-confidential. Therefore, the Office requests the Commission to exercise its authority under Utah Admin. Code R746-100-16.A.1.e. and impose additional protective measures by ordering that the Report be filed only with the Commission and be provided only to the Utah Division of Public Utilities and PacifiCorp.

No party filed a response to the relief the Office requests or expressed in any way any objection to the protective measures the Office proposes.

ORDER

The motion is granted. The Office shall file the Report only with the Commission and shall only disclose it to the Utah Division of Public Utilities and PacifiCorp. The Commission will address other parties' access to the Report if and when access is requested.
