In the Matter of PacifiCorp's 2011 Integrated Resource Plan PROPOSED ORDER ON UTAH OFFICE OF CONSUMER SERVICES' MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER – ADDITIONAL PROTECTIVE MEASURES

BEFORE THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF UTAH

On September 12, 2011, the Utah Office of Consumer Services filed its Motion for Protective Order – Additional Protective Measures, requesting that the Commission attach additional protective measures to the standing protective order applicable to this docket under Utah Admin. Code R. 746-100-16. The additional protective measures pertain to the "Report on Rocky Mountain Power Fuel Management and Coal Supply" (Report) prepared by Energy Ventures Analysis, referenced by the Office's September 7, 2011 Comments upon PacifiCorp's 2011 Integrated Resource Plan. The additional protective measures would allow the Office to file the Report with the Commission and serve it upon only the Utah Division of Public Utilities and PacifiCorp. The Office also moved that the additional protective measures provide a means by which other parties to this docket may request that the Commission grant the party access to the Report upon such terms and conditions as the Commission determines will protect the confidentiality of the Report.

More than 15 calendar days have past since the Motion was filed and no response has been filed. The Commission therefore presumes that there is no opposition. Utah Admin. R. 746-100-4 D. The Commission finds that the Office has established the need for the specific, additional protective measures, and the reasonableness of the requested, additional protection. The Commission finds that the Report is based upon and contains highly confidential information that if disclosed creates a high risk of competitive disadvantage or other business injury. Also, the Commission finds that the manner in which PacifiCorp imposed restrictions on the access and use of the information, the Office cannot create a public and non-public version of the Report that reliably protects the confidentiality of the information as required by Utah law.

Accordingly, it is ordered that the Office file the Report with the Commission as a highly confidential document; that the Office serve the Report upon only the Utah Division of Public Utilities and PacifiCorp; and that no public version of the Report is to be prepared.

Parties may request access to the Report or a copy of it, by filing a request with the Commission demonstrating that by reason of the organization, character,

activities, and purpose of the party and its interest in this docket, access to the Report will create no competitive disadvantage or advantage, nor can the party's use of the Report result in or risk business injury. Further, the party must demonstrate that access to the Report is necessary to its intervention in this docket and to permit it to represent its interest and positions of record.
