Subject:	Docket No. 12-035-68 re: Revise Rate in Renewable Energy Credits Balancing Account Compliance Filing

On May 18 Rocky Mountain Power (Company) filed with the Public Service Commission (Commission) Electric Service Schedule 98, REC Revenues Credit. The filing was made in compliance with the Commission's bench order in the Renewable Energy Credit Balancing Account (RBA) Docket, No. 12-035-68. In that docket the Office recommended that the billing determinants from the last general rate case, Docket No. 10-035-124, were the appropriate billing determinants to be used at this time for Schedule 98.

The Commission issued a bench order that the 2012 REC Revenues Credit was to be developed using the billing determinants from the last general rate case, Docket No. 10-035-124.

The Office has reviewed the Company's May 18 compliance filing and found no variations from the billing determinants used in Docket No. 10-035-124.
