Re: Docket No. 08-999-05 – Corrected Smart Grid Monitoring Report

On July 6, 2012, Rocky Mountain Power filed its 2012 Smart Grid Annual Report in the above referenced docket. The Company has discovered that corrections need to be made to that filing. The report, as originally filed, included an automatic date function that displays the current date whenever the report is opened. The correct report removes the automatic date function so both the printed and electronic versions of the document now show the June 29, 2012, report date. In addition two revisions, described below, have been made to the PacifiCorp 2012 Smart Grid Financial Model provided with the filing as confidential workpapers. These corrections impact Appendix A, but do not change the information presented in the body of the report. The Company will also provide an electronic version of this filing to psc@utah.gov. A Confidential CD containing workpapers supporting Appendix A will also be provided.

PacifiCorp's 2012 Smart Grid Financial Model required revision of two entries in the Interactive Volt/Var Optimization section. The first revision accounts for the cost of adding communication equipment to existing voltage monitoring equipment. The second revision was made to reflect that only residential energy is considered for Conservation Voltage Reduction, and therefore the percentage of applicable energy was lowered to 30% to represent the ratio of residential-to-total energy.

The Utah Addendum, Appendix A, and the workpapers to the 2012 Annual Smart Grid Report contain information that is commercially sensitive to Rocky Mountain Power and are confidential. Accordingly, Rocky Mountain Power is filing the confidential documents and workpapers under seal pursuant to R746-100-16, and requests that the Commission require any party who wishes to view these documents execute a Confidential Information Certificate.
