



Parties shall file testimony with the Commission in accordance with the foregoing schedule and shall follow the procedures set forth at “PSC Filing Requirements” under the “MISC” tab on the Utah Public Service Commission website homepage. Additionally, written testimony and other exhibits offered into evidence shall conform to Utah Administrative Code R746-100-10(F)(2). In particular, they shall adequately explain: “Explicit and detailed sources of the information contained in the exhibit; methods used in statistical compilations, including explanations and justifications; assumptions, estimates and judgments, together with the bases, justifications and results; formulas or algorithms used for calculations, together with explanations of inputs or variables used in the calculations.” Parties shall serve copies of all filings on other parties by electronic mail at or before the time an electronic copy of the document is required to be filed with the Commission.

For discovery requests served prior to December 21, 2012, responses shall be served within fourteen days. For discovery requests served on or after that date, responses shall be served within seven days. Where feasible, parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by electronic mail.

### **SCOPE OF PROCEEDING**

**The Commission desires to clarify the purpose of this proceeding. This proceeding is not about the location or siting of the Transmission Line, if it is built. The Commission does not have jurisdiction over the siting of transmission lines. This proceeding is to determine if present or future public convenience and necessity does or will require construction of a transmission line. We trust and expect that Rocky Mountain**

**Power will work in good faith with interested parties in seeking the most appropriate siting for transmission lines.**
