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## **RECOMMENDATION (Approval)**

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (Company) proposed modifications to Street and Area Lighting Schedules and Regulations, with an effective date of May 5, 2012.

## **ISSUE AND DISCUSSION**

On April 5, 2012, the Company filed its modified tariff pages for Regulation 12, "Line Extensions," Schedule 7, "Security Area Lighting," and Schedule 11, "Street Lighting, Company-Owned System." This tariff clarification filing makes changes to the Company's street lighting tariffs that will clean up and better clarify service provisions for street lighting customers. The filing also improves consistency across street lighting tariffs. The Division recommends that the Commission approve it.
