Re: Tariff Compliance Filing, Docket No. 12-035-T03, Advice No. 12-03 – Removal of the Schedule 192 Self-Direction Credit and Schedule 193 Demand-side Management Cost Adjustment Expiration Date. Division's Recommendation – Approval.

RECOMMENDATION (Approval)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (Company) proposed changes to Schedule 192 and Schedule 193, with an effective date of May 6, 2012.

ISSUE AND DISCUSSION

On April 6, 2012, the Company filed its revised Utah Tariff Schedule 192 (Self-Direction Credit) and Schedule 193 (Demand-Side Management Cost Adjustment). The Company requested approval of the removal of the March 31, 2014 expiration date from both Schedules, with an effective date of May 6, 2012. On May 4, 2012, the Commission issued its order in the above referenced docket approving the tariff sheet modifications and that the Company further modify the tariff language per recommendations made by the Division and file corrected tariff sheets for compliance review. The Division did not recommend any additional language changes.

Therefore any language modifications discussed by the Division in its approval recommendation

have already been incorporated into the tariff sheets. The Division concludes that the tariff sheets filed on April 6, 2012 are in compliance with the Commission Order dated May 4, 2012 recommends that the Commission approve them.
