Docket No. 12-035-T08, "The purpose of this filing is to add language in the Company's Regulation No. 8 to provide tariff language explaining the Company's proration methodology."

Dear Ms. Coughlin:

On June 8, 2012, based upon discussions surrounding a formal complaint regarding the proration of billing for the summer to winter rates and winter to summer rates, Rocky Mountain Power (Company) filed proposed revisions to Electric Service Regulation No. 8 "Billings," Sheets 8R.6 and 8R.7, and Electric Service Regulations Index Sheet No. D. The revised tariff pages add language to the Company's Regulation No. 8 explaining its proration method.

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) and the Office of Consumer Services (Office) filed memoranda on June 28 and 29, 2012, respectively, indicating their participation in developing the new language on billing proration. Both the Division and Office support the proposed revisions and recommend approval. The Division indicates the proposed language is consistent with that which was agreed upon and the Office supports the change as it provides customers the means to better understand and verify their own bills.

The Commission has reviewed the Company's revised tariff pages, the Division's memo, and Office's memo. Now therefore, the Company's revisions to Regulation No. 8 and associated Sheet No. D are approved by the Commission with an effective date of July 8, 2012.
