## **RECOMMENDATION (Approval)**

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (Company) proposed corrected Schedule 110 tariff sheets, with an effective date of September 8, 2012.

## **ISSUE AND DISCUSSION**

On July 5, 2012, the Company filed its revised Utah Tariff Schedule 110 (New Homes Program) to be in compliance with the Commission Order dated June 27, 2012. Following the July 5, 2012 filing, the Company found that it missed an appliance standard revision of the Consortium for Energy Efficiency (CEE) Super Efficient Home Appliances Initiative for Dishwasher Specification Standard. On January 20, 2012, the CEE Tier 1 Energy Factor for residential dishwashers' requirement increased from 0.72 to 0.75. There are no longer CEE Tier 2 requirements. August 9, 2012, the Company filed corrected Schedule 110 tariff sheets – 110.7



and 110.8. Upon review the Division concludes that the tariff sheets filed are in compliance with the updated CEE appliance standards and recommends that the Commission approve them.
