Subject: Docket No. 12-035-T12, Proposed Changes to Schedule 111,

Home Energy Savings Incentive Program (HES Program) and Cancellation of Schedule 113 Evaporative Cooling and Central Air Conditioning Incentive Program (Cool Cash Incentive Program)

## Background

On August 20, 2012, Rocky Mountain Power (Company) filed with the Public Service Commission (Commission) proposed changes to the HES Program, including integrating the Cool Cash Incentive Program.

## Discussion

The Office of Consumer Services (Office) reviewed the draft and sent the Company some clarifying questions. The Company's responses resolved the Office's questions except for some minor tariff corrections. The following items were omitted from the tariff:

- 1. The Daylight (4500 + Kelvin) CFL was not included in the tariff sheet 111.3
- 2. LED's were not included in the tariff.
- 3. Under the self-installed insulation section, wall insulation was not included in tariff sheet 111.4.

The Company is aware of these omissions and has indicated that it will submit updated tariff sheets to the Commission to include the items above. The Office has no objections with the tariff modifications to the HES Program as the Company proposed in this docket.

## Recommendation

The Office recommends that the Commission approve the changes proposed in this docket with the addition of updated Schedule 111 tariff sheets as described above.
