Included with this compliance filing are several housekeeping changes to the following tariff sheets:

Low Income Lifeline Program, Sheet 3.3. The references to Utah Department of Community and Culture (DCC) and been changed to Utah Department of Workforce Services (DWS). This reflects a change in the responsibility for the administration of the HELP program within Utah State government.

Avoided Cost Purchases from Qualifying Facilities, Sheet 37.2. The references to and application of holidays falling on Saturday have been removed. For more than 10 years, Saturdays have been considered an on peak day for the application of Schedule 37 prices. This change to the tariff sheet removes the internal inconsistency in the language in the tariff and aligns the language in the tariff with current practice.
