On December 20, 2013, Rocky Mountain Power (Company) filed with the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) its proposed reporting system in compliance with paragraph 30 of the settlement stipulation approved on November 7, 2013, in this matter. The purpose of the reporting system is to keep the stipulating parties and the Commission informed of matters likely to have implications regarding potential stranded costs of generating assets.

On January 7, 2014, the Commission issued a notice of filing and comment period specifying that any interested party submit comments on the Company's proposal on or before Friday, January 24, 2014, and replies by February 14, 2014. The Commission received no comments on the Company's proposal.

By this letter, the Commission acknowledges receipt of your December 20, 2014, proposed reporting system and acknowledges it is compliant with paragraph 30 of the settlement stipulation approved in Docket No. 13-035-02.
