In accordance with Rule 746-100-7 of the Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure and the Provisions of Utah Code Ann. § 63-46b-9, Holcim, Inc., Kennecott Utah Copper LLC, Kimberly-Clark Corp., Malt-O-Meal, Praxair, Inc., Proctor & Gamble, Inc., and Tesoro Refining and Marketing Co., (this group of electrical power customers will be referred to hereinafter, for convenience only, as the "Utah Industrial Energy Consumers" or "UIEC"), hereby petition the Utah Public Service Commission ("Commission") for leave to intervene in the above-referenced proceeding, and request that the Commission issue an order allowing UIEC to participate fully in this matter.

In support of its Petition to Intervene, the UIEC state as follows:

1. On January 3, 2014, PacifiCorp, doing business in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power ("RMP"), filed an Application for Approval of an Increase in it Rates and Charges,

requesting the Commission to approve a rate increase of approximately \$76.3 million to be recovered in general rates.

2. The interveners named in this Petition, herein referred to as the UIEC, are a group of industrial consumers each of which takes electrical service from RMP.

3. The consumers herein referred to as UIEC have joined together for the purposes of intervention in this docket to have their common interests represented. The interests of each of the UIEC consumers will not be adequately represented by any other party to this proceeding.

4. The consumers herein referred to as UIEC have a direct, immediate, and substantial interest in this proceeding as customers of RMP because the rate they pay for electric service may be affected by a Commission decision on RMP's Application for an Increase in its Rates and Charges.

5. If the consumers herein referred to as UIEC are granted leave to intervene in this proceeding, they hereby request that service of all pleadings, notices, etc. be made to the following:
