Utah Clean Energy hereby submits for filing an original and eleven copies of the Direct Testimony of Sarah Wright on behalf of Utah Clean Energy in the Revenue Requirement phase of the above-referenced proceeding (the Rocky Mountain Power general rate case). Utah Clean Energy has marked for filing two versions on this testimony: (1) a "Highly Confidential" version and (2) a "Public/Redacted" version.

Confidential information is provided subject to Utah PSC Rule R746-100-16. Additionally, Rocky Mountain Power has asserted a claim of confidentiality under Utah Code Ann. §63G-2-309 for a portion of this testimony on the grounds that information referenced has been designated by Rocky Mountain Power as Highly Confidential and should be protected under "business confidentiality." In its first supplemental response to Sierra Club data request 2.11(e), the Company waived its attorney-client privilege with respect to certain analysis of investments; notwithstanding this waiver, the Company indicated that the analysis is commercially sensitive and highly confidential. Utah Clean Energy references that analysis in direct testimony.

Utah Clean Energy consulted with the Company prior to filing this testimony in order to maintain the "trade secret, confidential or proprietary nature" of the Company's information, consistent with Utah PSC Rule R746-100-16.
