Utah's monopoly utility, Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) is working to stamp out competition from rooftop solar, and has requested (as part of its recent 2014 General Rate Case application) that the Utah Public Service Commission approve a new \$4.25 monthly fee for customers with rooftop solar. Investing in rooftop solar aligns our actions with our values and accomplishes many of our shared goals: cleaner air, increased self-reliance, greater energy independence, reduced risk from rising fuel costs and more local jobs. Let the PSC know that Utahns want more solar!
