Due to the high level of interest in Rocky Mountain Power's rate case (Docket No. 13-035-184), the Commission reminds interested parties that, consistent with the Commission's January 22, 2014, scheduling order, the hearing scheduled in this docket for Thursday, May 29, 2014, is being held solely to address cost of capital and rate of return issues. The public is invited to provide oral comments on any topic applicable to Rocky Mountain Power's rate case at the Public Witness Hearing scheduled for Tuesday, July 29, 2014, beginning at 5:00 p.m. (MDT), Fourth Floor Hearing Room 403, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah. **NOTE:** The Public Witness Hearing is scheduled to run from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Individuals planning to address the Commission at the Public Witness Hearing must be present by 6:00 p.m. (MDT); however, the Public Witness Hearing will continue until all individuals who are present by 6:00 p.m. (MDT) have had a reasonable opportunity to address the Commission.

Individuals wishing to participate in the Public Witness Hearing by telephone should contact the Commission two days in advance of the Public Witness Hearing by calling (801) 530-6716 or (toll-free) 1-866-PSC-UTAH (1-866-772-8824).

Participants attending by telephone should then call the Commission at the same number listed above five minutes prior to the hearing to ensure participation.
