I would like you to reject Rocky Mountain Power's request for a fee for using *Net Metering*. It's discriminatory because it penalizes households that use *Net Metering*. Actually, those of us with *Net Metering* should be given a credit since we use less electricity than non users. This reduces the demand upon the system, similar to their own *Cool Keeper* program. That program monitors usage and turns off my air conditioner during high demand times. Well, with my solar panels, during the day (high demand time), I usually generate enough energy to remove my house from the grid, reducing the demand. In fact, on sunny days I generate enough electricity to cover my usage and still send electricity to Rocky Mountain Power to use for their high demand.
