## RECOMMENDATION

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) requests the Commission issue notice of a scheduling conference in Docket No. 13-035-32.

## **ISSUE AND DISCUSSION**

On March 15, 2013 Rocky Mountain Power (Company) filed an application with the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) to increase the deferred EBA rate through the Energy Balancing Account mechanism (EBA). On March 18, 2013 the Commission issued an action request to the Division requesting the Division review the application and make recommendations. The Division requests that the Commission issue notice of a scheduling conference at the earliest opportunity. The Division will review the application and make recommendations according to the schedule issued in the Commission's scheduling order. The Division therefore recommends that the Commission close the Action Request in this matter.
