Corrections to the Rocky Mountain Power 2012 Energy Efficiency and Peak Load

Reduction Annual Report

On May 1, 2013, Rocky Mountain Power filed the 2012 Energy Efficiency and Peak Load Reduction Annual Report. Comments submitted by the Office of Consumer Services and Division of Public Utilities identified a data omission and errors in the report. The Company has corrected the following omission and errors:

- 1. In Docket No. 09-035-27 on Dec. 21, 2009, the Commission ordered the Company to include the lifetime megawatt-hour savings in addition to first year savings. The report has been updated to include the required information on page 7 of the 2012 Energy Efficiency and Peak Load Reduction Annual Report
- 2. Under the "Infrastructure" sub-heading on page 45, Table 45 was incorrectly referenced. The Company has corrected the reference to Table 38.
- 3. Information on Irrigation Load Control in Appendix 1 of the report, incorrectly referenced Table 2 of the Report. The Company has corrected the reference to direct readers to Table 3.

The Company has responded to three sets of Data Requests from the Office of Consumer Services and believes that our responses to those inquiries have satisfied all other comments and inquiries on the 2012 Energy Efficiency and Peak Load Reduction Annual Report.

Rocky Mountain Power hereby submits for filing an original and ten copies of corrections to the 2012 Energy Efficiency and Peak Load Reduction Annual ReportThe Company respectfully requests that the Commission accept these corrections and approve the new tariff with an effective date of July 1, 2013.
