Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) should not penalize solar customers with a monthly fee. The benefits of solar power far outweigh the total damage the RMP coal fired power plants do to the health of people, our communities, our environment and the planet. With home solar RMP gets free excess electricity and does not have to increase generating capacity.

RMP's solar costs/benefits study must:

1. Address the economic and environmental costs of burning coal: the costs solar helps avoid.
2. Include all solar customers in the study, not just residential. Non-residential and commercial solar customers contribute, too.
3. Use independent researchers to gather and analyze data. Don't rely on RMP and PacifiCorp.
