PREHEARING NOTICE

ISSUED: September 21, 2015

The Commission issues this Prehearing Notice to give parties notice regarding two matters in advance of the hearing in this docket, which will commence at the time and place stated in the Commission's March 19, 2015 First Order Amending Scheduling Order.

First, unless the parties stipulate to a different order or otherwise seek relief on the matter, the Commission expects the default order for the presentation of evidence will be as follows: the Division of Public Utilities will present its evidence, the Office of Consumer Services will follow the Division of Public Utilities, PacifiCorp dba Rocky Mountain Power will follow the Office of Consumer Services, and those parties who have intervened will present evidence last. The Alliance for Solar Choice, Sierra Club and Utah Clean Energy, which have commonly identified themselves as the "Joint Parties" and jointly filed written testimony will present first among the intervenors. Salt Lake City Corporation may present evidence after the Joint Parties and Vivint Solar, Inc. may present evidence after Salt Lake City Corporation.

Second, the Commission has reviewed the parties' pre-filed written testimony and appreciates the considerable effort the parties have made in developing their recommendations in this docket. To ensure these proceedings are as productive as possible and recognizing that some parties have answered these questions in their filed testimony, the Commission asks the parties' witnesses come to the hearing prepared to testify to the following matters with respect to their recommendations: (1) what tools (*e.g.*, GRID) the party recommends using for valuing each

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metric in the framework the party is advocating; (2) to the extent a new tool will be required in order to implement a party's recommendation, specific recommendations as to how the tool may be feasibly developed; and (3) the period of time the party recommends analyzing for each component of its recommended framework, including whether such period is historic or forecast and the duration of the period to be analyzed.
