**Re: Docket No. 14-035-140, In the Matter of Review of Electric Service Schedule No. 38, Qualifying Facilities Procedures, and Other Related Procedural Issues**

Dear Public Service Commission,

In the Surrebuttal Testimony of Mr. Ken Dragoon, filed by Utah Clean Energy in Docket No. 14-035-140, Mr. Dragoon indicated that Utah Clean Energy was, at the time of filing, still awaiting responses to its last set of discovery requests (Surrebuttal Testimony of Ken Dragoon for Utah Clean Energy, line 101, note 2) regarding transmission constraints in Wyoming and their impact on the capacity contribution of renewable resources in Utah.

Yesterday, on June 17, Rocky Mountain Power provided answers to Utah Clean Energy's fourth (and final) set of discovery requests. In the interest of developing a full and complete record in this case, Utah Clean Energy is filing the attached exhibit (Utah Clean Energy Exhibit 3.2) to accompany the Surrebuttal Testimony of Mr. Ken Dragoon, with specific reference to lines 93-101 and notes 1 and 2. Given that the hearing in this proceeding has been canceled, Utah Clean Energy will separately file an offer of this evidence to be accepted by the Commission into the formal record of this proceeding.

Enclosed for filing are an original and eleven copies of Utah Clean Energy Exhibit 3.2 and Utah Clean Energy's Offer to admit of the same as evidence to the record.
