On February 7, 2014, Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp ("PacifiCorp"), filed a request for approval ("Request") of its agreement with Helper City, Utah ("City") whereby PacifiCorp and the City agree that PacifiCorp will continue providing electric service to certain customers ("Customers") located within the City's municipal boundaries ("Agreement"). PacifiCorp indicates the City and PacifiCorp entered into the Agreement, subject to the Commission's approval, in compliance with Utah Code Ann. §§ 54-3-31(2) and 54-4-40.

On March 11, 2014, the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") filed comments pursuant to the Commission's February 12, 2014, Amended Notice of Filing and Comment Period, recommending approval of the Agreement. According to the Division, PacifiCorp represents the City does not have facilities located near the Customers and therefore it is presently uneconomic for the City to provide electric service to the Customers. Conversely, it is relatively convenient and economical for PacifiCorp to continue to provide service to the Customers, as it has done for the past 10 years. Finally, the Division indicates the Agreement will not affect any other current PacifiCorp customers.

The Commission has not received any opposition to PacifiCorp's Request.

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#### **ORDER**

Based on the Division's recommendation, the lack of opposition to the Request, and for other good cause appearing, the Request is approved.
