Reduction Report pursuant to Commission order in Docket No. 12-035-116

Rocky Mountain Power (Company) respectfully requests a one-time extension on the filing date of the 2013 Demand Side Management Annual Report (Report) from May 1 to May 16, 2014.

On December 12, 2012, the Company filed a motion to permanently move the required delivery date from March 31st to May 1st due primarily to the annual delivery timeline of the information necessary to compile the Report. This request was approved by Commission Order in Docket 12-035-116, effective January 15, 2013.

The Company is requesting a 15 day extension in 2014. The necessity of the extension is due to unexpected staffing constraints in the Demand Side Management Department which have impacted the ability of staff to complete the annual report in a timely manner. The Company expects to resolve the constraints quickly and does not foresee any additional need for extensions on demand side management filings.
