RE: Docket No. 14-035-55/Docket No. 14-035-T04 – Schedule 37 Avoided Cost Purchases from Qualifying Facilities (QF)

Enclosed for filing, in accordance with the Commission's December 30, 2014, Order on Review, please find an original and ten (10) copies of Rocky Mountain Power's Utah Schedule 37 Compliance Filing. This filing includes updated tariffs and rates that are consistent with the Order on Review.

In addition and pursuant to the October Report and Order, the Company is filing concurrently for the Commission's review and approval, tariffs with updated Schedule 37 prices that exclude a simple-cycle combustion turbine in the sufficiency period, but are differentiated between peak and off-peak based on the relationship of Palo Verde On-Peak and Off-peak market prices to Palo Verde flat market prices, respectively. The October Report and Order directed the Company to file "a possible adjustment to the method for Schedule 37 that produces distinct peak and off-peak rates in the resource sufficiency period, by April 30, 2015, or its next Schedule 37 rate update, whichever is sooner." These tariffs are also identical to those provided with the Company's Petition for Reconsideration, Review or Rehearing previously filed in this Docket. As described in the Petition for Reconsideration, Review or Rehearing, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission approve these prices for the reasons more fully stated therein.
