RECOMMENDATION

After review of the tariff sheets filed in Docket No. 14-035-T01, the Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) approve the tariff sheets with an effective date of April 6, 2014.

ISSUE

On April 4, 2014 the Commission issued its Order approving the tariff sheets with modifications and requiring the Company to file appropriate tariff revisions reflecting the changes within 14 days after the date of the Order. The Company submitted its finalized tariff sheets on April 8, 2014. On April 8, 2014, the Commission issued its Action Request to the Division to review the tariff sheets for compliance and make recommendations by April 22, 2014. This memo is in response to the Commission's Action Request.



DISCUSSION

The Division has reviewed the tariff sheets and notes the changes as ordered by the Commission are properly reflected in the tariff sheets.

CONCLUSION

The Division has reviewed the tariff and recommends approving the proposed changes to tariff Schedule No. 114, Air Conditioner Direct Load Control Program (Cool Keeper Program), pages 114.1 through 114.5.
