In Advice No. 14-03, in the above referenced docket, the Company requested an effective date of June 6, 2014. In order to align the program changes with the adoption of the new State of Utah Energy Code, the Company respectfully requests a new proposed effective date of July 1, 2014.

The code change is discussed in the filing and was considered in the cost effectiveness analysis that was included as Attachment C. The Company believes that aligning the dates will decrease administrative burden and provide clarity for customers with projects impacted by code standards. We believe these issues outweigh the benefits of introducing new program elements into the market earlier than they otherwise will be.
