In its February 12, 2009 order in Docket 08-035-78, the Commission directed Rocky Mountain Power to update annually the valuation of net excess generation credits for large non-residential customers in Schedule 135, Net Metering Service, to reflect the average retail rates for the previous year's Federal Energy Regulation Commission Form No. 1.

Enclosed for filing are an original and five (5) copies of the proposed tariff page associated with Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 49 of Rocky Mountain Power applicable to electric service in the State of Utah. Also provided with this filing is Exhibit 1, which shows the calculation of the average retail rate credit prices for large non-residential customers.
