Docket No. 14-035-T07, "In the Matter of Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 118, Low Income Weatherization"

Dear Mr. Taylor:

On June 23, 2014, Rocky Mountain Power ("Company") filed proposed revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 118, "Low Income Weatherization." The Company maintains the changes do not alter the program and are housekeeping in nature.

On July 8, 2014, the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") and the Office of Consumer Services ("Office") filed comments on the proposed changes. The Division reviewed the proposed changes and recommends Commission approval. The Office recommends the Commission approve the proposed changes to Schedule No. 118 with one exception, namely the Company's proposal to eliminate language on Sheet 118.5 stating that "Installations shall meet Federal, State and Local building codes." The Office recommends the Commission deny this change unless the language is replaced by language of equivalent meaning.

On July 15, 2014, the Company filed reply comments explaining its reasoning for removal of the above referenced language. The Company responded to the Office's concern by providing an updated tariff Sheet 118.5 containing proposed alternate language specifying the Housing and Community Development Division will ensure installation meets Federal, State and Local building codes. The Commission finds this language adequately addresses the concerns identified by the Office.

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The Commission also notes the wording in the footer on the updated tariff Sheet 118.5 referencing “Advice No. 14-035-T07” is conflicting as the reference should either be “Advice No. 14-06” or “Docket No. 14-035-T07.” The Commission requests the Company file a corrected tariff Sheet 118.5 to resolve this inconsistency.

The Company’s revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 118, with the language revisions to Sheet 118.5 provided on July 15, 2014, and the correct footer reference mentioned above, are approved by the Commission with an effective date of August 1, 2014.
