The big box stores only sale the cheapest product they can find. The color rendering of big box store LED's are poor and the Lumen output is low compared to what the wholesale distributors sale. If you want people to save energy then it should be with a quality product. This would help get the customers to change over to the LED's. Electrical wholesale distributors should be allowed the same option as the big box store. **This would help keep the money in Utah.** I will have no incentive to continue to talk my clients into upgrading to LED's since I won't make any money to do so. I just finished a new constriction house and talked the customer into changing from the incandescent bulbs to LED's. This was 75 fixtures which without the whole sale distribution would never have happened.
