As you know presently Rocky Mountain Power customers purchase LED or other energy saving lighting from numerous sellers and they, the customer, file the rebate themselves either by mail or online on Rocky Mountain Power's website with their proof of purchase and Rocky Mountain Power account number.

I am involved with sales of LED fixtures for this market in Cache Valley, Utah and have sold about \$200,000 of these products this year in this relatively small market.

It would be unfair to change this program to close this opportunity for numerous small businesses many of which are Rocky Mountain Power customers.

This program has reduced Rocky Mountain Power energy consumption by thousands of kilowatt hours and it is not justified to broad brush this now with a few large box stores just to reduce the rebate processing expense.
