
On January 14, 2015, the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) issued an Order Setting Schedule and Suspending Tariff and Notice of Hearing in the above referenced matter. Rocky Mountain Power (“Company”) provides these reply comments in response to comments filed January 21, 2015 by the Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Consumer Services and Utah Clean Energy (collectively, the “Parties”).

The Company appreciates Parties’ comments in support of adjusting the Schedule 193 Surcharge rate to 3.62% effective February 1, 2015. The Company also supports this adjustment and believes it is a reasonable first step in bringing the demand-side management balancing account into balance while minimizing the 2015 impact on customer rates. The Company will discuss the balancing account with the Steering Committee at its next meeting, and request a second adjustment mid-year if warranted.

The Company will also discuss the DSM carrying charge with the Division of Public Utilities at a 2015 Steering Committee meeting, so it can be addressed in a future proceeding.
