1	Q.	Please state your name and occupation?
2	A.	My name is Matthew Allen Croft. I am employed by the Utah Division of Public Utilities
3		("Division") as a Utility Technical Consultant.
4	Q.	What is your business address?
5	A.	Heber M. Wells Office Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, 84111.
6	Q.	Did you previously file direct testimony in this docket (15-035-03)?
7	A.	Yes.
8	Q.	What is the purpose of the testimony that you are now filing?
9	A.	I am filling supplemental direct testimony to address the impact of the Gadsby outage
10		adjustment discussed in the Energy Balancing Account (EBA) audit reports previously filed
11		by the Division and La Capra Associates (La Capra). La Capra is also filing supplemental
12		testimony to address this issue.
13	Q.	What is the impact of the Gadsby outage adjustment?
14	A.	La Capra has determined the Gadsby outage adjustment to be a reduction of total Company
15		net power costs of \$25,809. This adjustment reduces Utah's EBA deferral balance by \$8,624.
16		With this adjustment, the Division's total recommended EBA deferral balance disallowance
17		is \$389,902. Accompanied with this testimony are Supplemental DPU Exhibits 1.4.0 and
18		1.4.1 which calculate the adjustment amounts.
