In response to email requests from Scott Allegrucci regarding the availability of 2015 IRP documents modeled on the company's 2013 IRP Core Case Fact Sheets and the availability for timely comment by stakeholders on the company's Core Case assumptions, we appreciated the response via email on September 18, 2014 that stated "yes we will provide the draft Core Case Fact sheets and will consider comments prior to finalizing modeling. We are hoping to have an initial cut of the sheets available at next week's meeting."

Core Case Fact Sheets or assumptions were made available during that meeting. In an effort to maximize the efficiency of our efforts and resources and allow adequate time for stakeholders in the 2015 IRP to review and comment upon the company's 2015 IRP Core Case assumptions we submit the following requests to PacifiCorp for the 2015 IRP process:

1. Develop and distribute a document for the 2015 IRP that details the company's Core Case assumptions, including supply-side resource assumptions;
2. Make a draft of that those assumptions available to public partners engaged in the 2015 IRP process and accept comments from stakeholders on the company's Core Case assumptions prior to initiating any modeling runs or finalizing any core case assumptions; and
3. Share the final version of a 2015 IRP Portfolio Development and Core Case Fact Sheets document with stakeholders in the 2015 IRP process prior to release of modeling run results.
