I'm writing to express my concern that PacifiCorp's latest resource plan would continue investments in aging coal plants, putting ratepayers on the hook for as much as 1.3 billion dollars over the next decade to prolong the lives of over a dozen coal plants.

If PacifiCorp's would instead spend those dollars on new cleaner energy sources we would all literally breath easier. And if they would stop trying to kill individual solar power by adding extra fees to people who spend their own money on solar systems, they perhaps would realize that all that money that individuals spend on solar panels is money they do not have to spend themselves.
