Dear Mr. Larsen:

On May 21, 2015, the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) received Rocky Mountain Power’s (“Company”) Major Event Report filing requesting major event exclusion for the weather-related events on April 14 - 16, 2015. If the request is approved the Company indicated it will exclude outage information for these events from its network performance reporting and from customer guarantee failure payments.

On June 22, 2015, the Utah Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) filed its action request response memorandum detailing its investigation of this event and recommending the Commission approve the Company’s application for major event exclusion. The Division also concludes the Company’s restoration effort was adequate. On July 7, 2015, the Company filed reply comments summarizing the filings in this docket and noting the Division’s effort and cooperation in evaluating the April 14 - 16 event.

By this letter, the Commission acknowledges receipt of your filings of May 21 and July 7, 2015, as well as the Division’s recommendation, and approves the April 14 - 16, 2015, weather-related events as a Major Event.
