RECOMMENDATION

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) accept the finalized tariff sheets, Schedule No. 110 – Residential New Homes Program, as submitted by Rocky Mountain Power (Company) on June 25, 2015.

ISSUE

On May 15, 2015, the Company filed proposed changes to Utah Tariff Schedule No. 110 Residential New Homes Program with an effective date of July 1, 2015. On June 1, 2015, the Division, the Office of Consumer Services, and Utah Clean Energy provided comments in response to the Commission's Notice of Filing and Comment Period. On June 8, 2015 the Company provided reply comments. The Commission issued its order approving the proposed changes to Schedule No. 110 with modifications on June 15, 2015. On June 25, 2015 the Company filed compliance tariff sheets pursuant to the order issued on June 15, 2015. Subsequently, the Commission issued an Action Request to the Division to review the tariff for



compliance to the Commission order. The Division provides these comments in response to the Commission's Action Request.

DISCUSSION

The Commission's order, dated June 15, 2015, approved the Company's request to change the Schedule No. 110, New Homes Program, with the modification that incentives will not be provided for air source heat pumps where natural gas is available at the property line.

CONCLUSION

The Division has reviewed the Company's revised tariff sheets as filed on June 25, 2015, and find they accurately reflect the changes ordered by the Commission. Therefore, the Division recommends the Commission accept the revised tariff sheets to Electric Service Schedule No. 110.
