Dear Mr. Comeau,

On May 15, 2015, Rocky Mountain Power filed Advice Letter No. 15-08, proposing changes to Electric Service Schedule No. 110, New Homes Program (Schedule 110), requesting an effective date of July 1, 2015. On June 15, 2015, the Commission issued an order in this docket (Order) approving the proposed changes to Schedule 110, except for the incentive for air source heat pumps where natural gas is available at the property line, and directed Rocky Mountain Power to file revised tariff sheets consistent with the Order by June 26, 2015. On June 25, 2015, Rocky Mountain Power filed a revised tariff Sheet No. 110.2 and the Commission issued an Action Request to the Division of Public Utilities (Division) to review the revised tariff sheet for compliance with the Order.

On June 29, 2015, the Division responded to the Action Request stating the revisions to Sheet No. 110.2 accurately reflect the Commission's Order and recommended the Commission approve revised tariff Sheet No. 110.2 as filed.

Based on the recommendation of the Division, the Commission approves revised tariff Sheet No. 110.2, as filed on June 25, 2015, with an effective date of July 1, 2015.
