Re: Advice Letter No. 15-10 in Docket No. 15-035-T09, Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 135, Net Metering Service

Dear Mr. Lively,

The Commission has reviewed the proposed revised tariff sheet and accompanying Exhibit 1 transmitted with Rocky Mountain Power's letter dated May 29, 2015, in Docket No. 15-035-T09 entitled above. The revised tariff page, filed in accordance with the Commission's February 12, 2009, Order in Docket No. 08-035-78, "In the Matter of the Consideration of Changes to Rocky Mountain Power's Schedule No. 135 - Net Metering Service," presents Rocky Mountain Power's proposed updated rates applicable to large non-residential customers who select the FERC Form No. 1 compensation method to receive credit for net excess generation. The proposed rates represent a 1.8 percent increase for Schedule No. 6, a 3.4 percent increase for Schedule No. 6A, a 10 percent increase for Schedule No. 6B, a 2.4 percent increase for Schedule No. 8, and a 1.7 percent increase for Schedule No. 10.

On June 17, 2015, the Division of Public Utilities (Division) filed a memorandum indicating it had reviewed the proposed tariff page modifications, as well as the accompanying Exhibit 1 which contains the calculation of average retail rate credit prices for large non-residential customers. The Division recommends the Commission approve the proposed tariff page revisions as they comply with the above-referenced Order.

Based on the Division's review, the Commission approves the proposed tariff sheet filed on May 29, 2015, with an effective date of July 1, 2015.
