Re: Docket No. 16-031-T01 – In the Matter of Mt. Wheeler Power, Inc.'s Tariff Revisions

Dear Mr. Ewell:

The Commission reviewed the March 28, 2016 filing by Mt. Wheeler Power, Inc. (Mt. Wheeler). Mt. Wheeler's filing consists of new tariff sheets for Large General Service Industrial Transmission (LGS-IT), with an effective date of March 8, 2016, and updated tariff sheets for Large General Service Industrial (LGS-I), with an effective date of July 1, 2016. The Commission also reviewed the action request response of the Division of Public Utilities (Division) filed on April 11, 2016.

The Division explains that Mt. Wheeler's new LGS-IT rate addresses the needs of a new customer and the LGS-I rate increase addresses existing customers who are all located outside of Utah. According to the Division, the rates were approved by Mt. Wheeler on March 8, 2016. The Division notes that it advised Mt. Wheeler of its obligation to officially notify the Commission at least 30 days before implementing new rates. However, since the customers affected by Mt. Wheeler's filing are not located within Utah, the Division recommends the Commission acknowledge the tariff changes as filed.

Based on the Commission's review of the filing and the comments received, the Commission acknowledges Mt. Wheeler's tariff changes for the LGS-I rate for any Utah customers, effective July 1, 2016. The Commission also acknowledges Mt. Wheeler's tariff changes for the LGS-IT rate for any Utah customers effective 30 days after the public notice of rate increase was completed as required under Utah Code Ann. § 54-3-3, or April 27, 2016, whichever Mt. Wheeler elects.
