Dear Mr. Lively:

The Commission reviewed the February 3, 2016 filing by PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power (PacifiCorp), requesting acknowledgment of the Procurement Policy and Procedures Updates. As part of the filing, PacifiCorp also proposed that future updates to the Procurement Policy and Procedures would be submitted to the Commission the earlier of general rate case filings or every five years. The Commission also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (Division) and the Office of Consumer Services (Office), filed on May 3, 2016, and April 29, 2016, respectively.

The Commission observes the Procurement Policy and Procedures Updates are acceptable to both the Division and the Office, each of which raised no objections to the proposed updates. The Division concluded the proposed updates are reasonable and will not hinder PacifiCorp from operating in a manner that would result in the lowest cost procurements. The Office concluded the proposed updates are in the public interest.

Based on the Commission's review of PacifiCorp's filing and the recommendations of the Division and the Office, the Commission acknowledges the Procurement Policy and Procedures Updates as filed. The Commission approves PacifiCorp's proposed update schedule of the earlier of general rate case filings or every five years.
