NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD

Any interested parties may submit comments on or before **Monday, March 14, 2016**, on the issue of whether this matter should be conducted formally or informally, and reply comments addressing the same issue may be submitted no later than **Monday, March 21, 2016**.

NOTICE OF INITIAL HEARING

The Utility Facility Review Board (Board) will conduct an initial hearing in this docket on **Wednesday, March 23, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., Fourth Floor Room 401**, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah. Interested parties should come prepared to discuss the issues and deadlines referenced below.

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 54-14-101 et seq. of the Utility Facility Review Board Act, the Board is to convene an initial hearing within 50 days of the date review is initiated,¹ at which a determination shall be made addressing a) whether this proceeding shall be conducted

formally or informally, and b) a schedule for the proceeding.² The Board is to hold a hearing on the merits within 60 days after the initial hearing,³ and a written decision is due within 75 days thereafter.⁴

Individuals wishing to participate by telephone should contact the Public Service Commission two days in advance by calling (801) 530-6716 or (toll-free) 1-866-PSC-UTAH (1-866-772-8824). Participants attending by telephone should then call the Public Service Commission at one of the numbers posted above five minutes before the conference to ensure participation.
