# SCHEDULING ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING

#### **DISCOVERY AND FILINGS**

Parties shall use their best efforts to respond to requests for data or discovery within seven calendar days of receipt. If a party is unable to respond within seven calendar days, it shall give the requesting party notice before the seventh day that it will be unable to deliver the requested discovery by the seventh day and provide a reasonable estimate of the time it will require to produce it. Parties shall serve copies of all filings on other parties by electronic mail <u>at</u> <u>or before</u> the time an electronic copy of the document is filed with the Commission.
