6	the Power Purchase Agreement between PacifiCorp and
7	Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company, LLC.
8	I'm Melanie Reif. I'm the presiding officer
9	for the Utah Public Service Commission. Welcome again
10	to our hearing this morning. And let's go ahead and
11	start with appearances, starting with you,
12	Mr. Solander.
13	MR. SOLANDER: Thank you. Daniel Solander
14	appearing on behalf of Rocky Mountain Power. And I
15	have with me at counsel table Kyle Moore, power
16	marketer/originator for PacifiCorp.
17	CHAIRMAN REIF: Thank you.
18	MR. JETTER: Good morning. I'm Justin Jetter
19	representing the Utah Division of Public Utilities.
20	With me at counsel table is Jeff Einfeldt, utility
21	analyst for the Division of Public Utilities.
22	CHAIRMAN REIF: Thank you. Welcome,
23	Mr. Einfeldt. Do we have anyone here representing the
24	Office this morning? The record should reflect that
25	there is no one here representing the Office this

3	MR. SOLANDER: Thank you. Rocky Mountain
4	Power would like to call Kyle Moore as its witness in
5	support of the agreement between PacifiCorp and Tesoro
6	Refining and Marketing Company.
7	CHAIRMAN REIF: Mr. Moore, I swore you in a
8	little bit earlier, and I'd just like to remind you
9	that you are still under oath. So you may proceed with
10	your testimony.

12	KYLE MOORE,
13	having been first duly sworn to tell the
14	truth, was examined and testified as follows:
15	000
16	THE WITNESS: Thank you. I present today for
17	Commission approval a Qualifying Facility Power
18	Purchase Agreement between Tesoro Refining and
19	Marketing Company and PacifiCorp.
20	The agreement provides for the sale to
21	PacifiCorp of energy to be generated by Tesoro up to
22	25 megawatts from a gas-fired cogeneration facility
23	owned by Tesoro and located in Salt Lake City, Utah.
24	The agreement is for a term of 12 months,
25	January 1, 2017, to December 31, 2017. The purchase

1	prices set forth in the agreements were calculated
2	using the methodology approved by the Commission orders
3	in Docket No. 03-035-14.
4	The company filed the PPA for approval
5	September 21, 2016. In comments filed on November 3,
6	2016, the PPU recommended that the language in the
7	agreement referencing the 2010 protocol be updated to
8	the 2017 protocol.
9	The DPU further recommended that the
10	Commission order the company to provide with future
11	Power Purchase Agreements filings the grid outputs and
12	Excel spreadsheets supporting the price calculations
13	and spreadsheets showing the voided line loss
14	calculations.
15	Further, the DPU recommended that the company
16	continue to provide at least quarterly hourly Power
17	Purchase Reports. The company filed a revised PPA on
18	November 14, 2016, addressing the concerns about the
19	protocol language. And it is my opinion that it
20	does it is in it does follow the 2017 protocol.
21	The agreement is compliant with relevant
22	Commission orders and with Utah Schedule 38.
23	Therefore, the company requests the Commission approve
24	the agreement.
25	MR. SOLANDER: Does that conclude your

- 10 with the Utah Division of Public Utilities, have you
- 11 had the opportunity to review the application and
- 12 additional filings made by the company in this docket?
- 13 A. Yes.
- Q. And did you create and cause to be filed with
- 15 the Commission an Action Request Response November 3,
- 16 2016?
- 17 A. Yes.
- 18 Q. And have you had the opportunity to review
- 19 the November 14th updated language in an amended Power
- 20 Purchase Agreement filed by the company?
- 21 A. Yes, I have.
- 22 Q. And does that amended language in that
- 23 November 14th, 2016, filed amended contract satisfy
- 24 your concerns that you had expressed in the
- 25 recommendation?
