Re: **Reply Comments**
In the Matter of Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Revisions to Electric Service
Schedule No. 140, Non-Residential Energy Efficiency Program
Docket No. 16-035-T03

On February 10, 2016, the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) issued a Notice of Filing and Comment period, allowing parties to file comments by February 24, 2016 and reply comments by February 29, 2016. The Division of Public Utilities (“DPU”), the Office of Consumer Services (“OCS”), Utah Clean Energy (“UCE”), and Southwest Energy Efficiency Project (“SWEEP”)¹ filed comments on February 24, 2016. Rocky Mountain Power (“Company”) provides these reply comments in response to party comments.

The DPU and OCS both recommend that the Commission approve the proposed modifications to Schedule 140. OCS requested that reference information be added to the tariff measure tables, which the Company is including as part of these reply comments, in addition to other minor updates to the tariff sheets, as further described below.

UCE/SWEEP’s comments contained a number of questions, which they requested clarity to prior to the Commission approving the Company’s proposed changes to Schedule 140. The Company held a call with UCE and SWEEP on February 26, 2016, to address their questions. UCE and SWEEP gained the clarity they requested in their comments and are supportive of the proposed modifications to Schedule 140, effective March 10, 2016.

The Company inadvertently omitted Note 8 under Table 3a on Sheet No. 140-10, and inadvertently deleted Note 2 under Table 5 on Sheet No. 140-15. Accordingly, the Company is providing updated Sheet Nos. 140-10 and 140-15 to correct these errors. In addition, per OCS’ request, the Company is also providing an updated Sheet No. 140-4 to add basic reference information in Table 1a under Eligibility Requirements, and fix a spelling error in Note 4.
